Celebrate and Advocate


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Where we work

- 90% of CSCLXT members work front line and the other 10% work in leadership, administration, or post-secondary education.
- Our membership extends across Alberta, Saskatchewan, British Columbia, Manitoba, Yukon, and the Northwest Territories.
 - o 66% work in rural (< 15,000)
 - o 9% Suburban (15-30,000)
 - 11% Urban (>30,000 1,3000,000)
 - o 14% Multisite/travel
- 75% CLXTs primarily work in the hospital setting while clinics as the second largest primary worksite.
- Some CLXTs have advanced authorization in medication preparation, transfusion medicine, IV, or bone densitometry.
